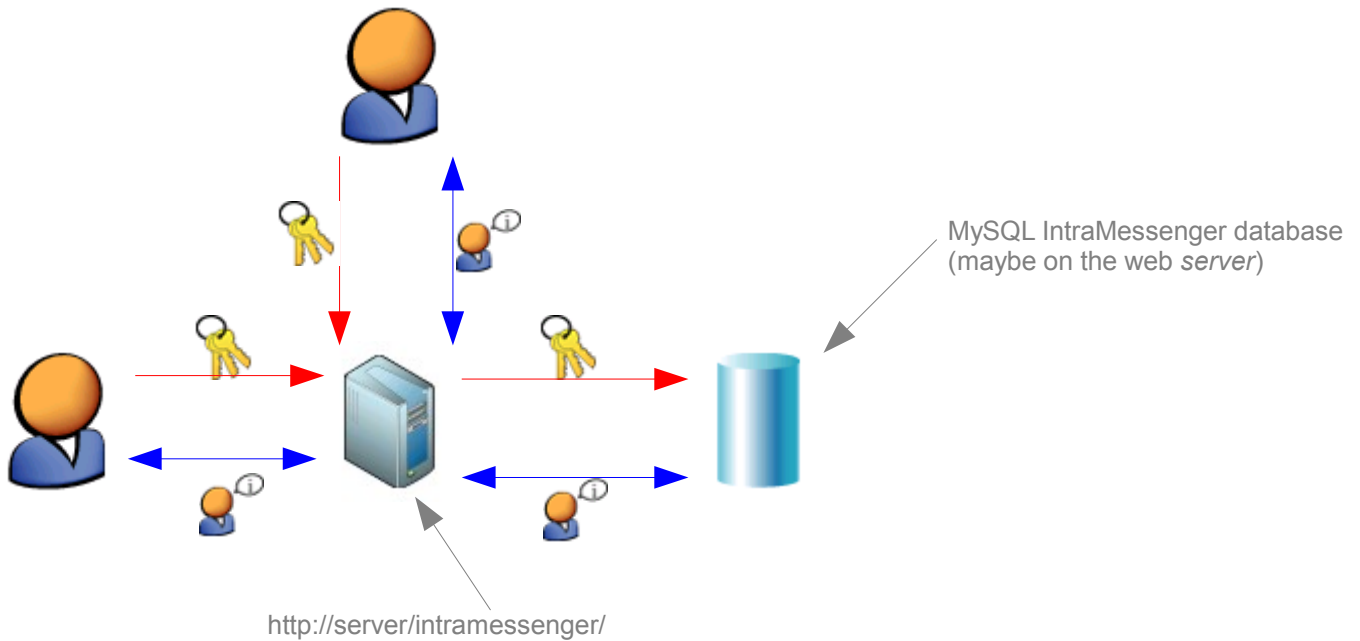
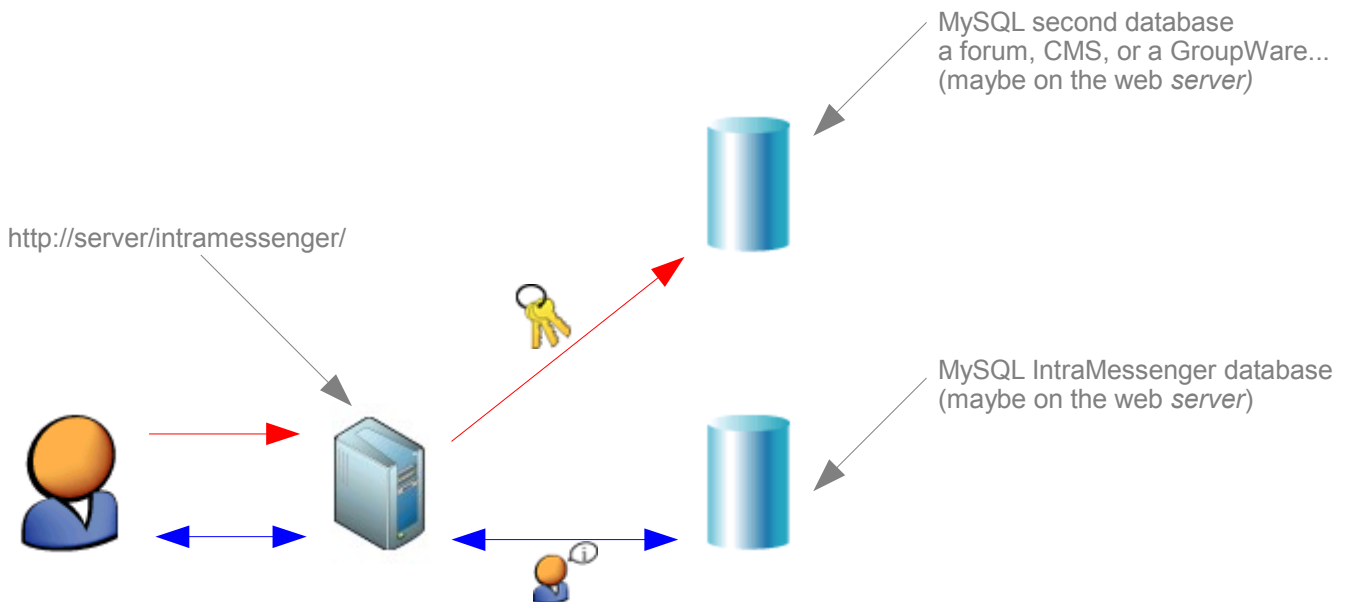


1. Normal **IntraMessenger** usage : many users connect to the web server, database can be on the server, or on a second one. Step 1 (red arrows) : check user already exist (and password good). If user not exist, he be created (if options). Step 2 (blue arrows) : messaging.



2. **IntraMessenger** with external authentication (example : a forum).

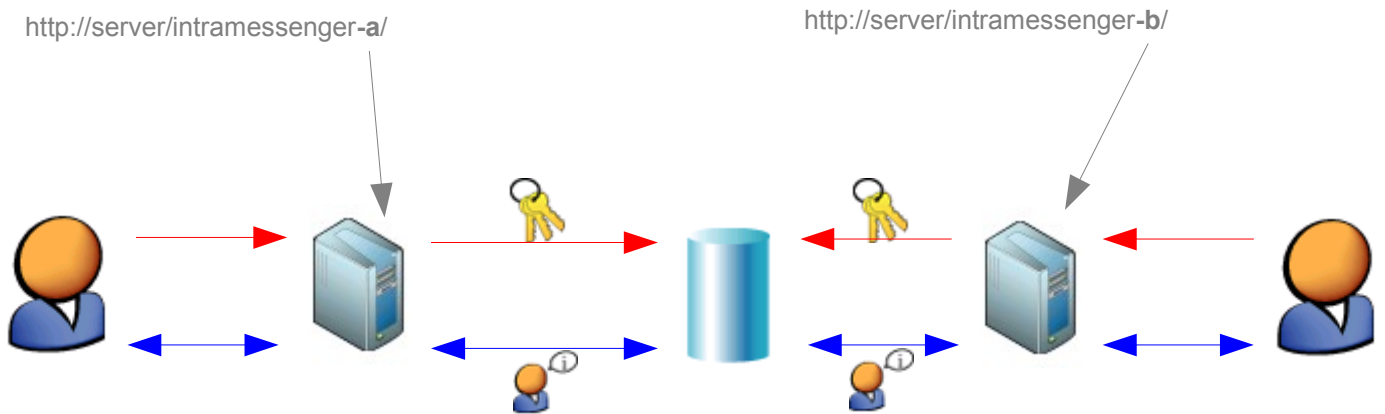
Users connect to the web server, but must already exist in forum for authenticcate.
 Step 1 (red arrows) : check if user already exist in extern database (and password good).
 If user not exist, he rejected.



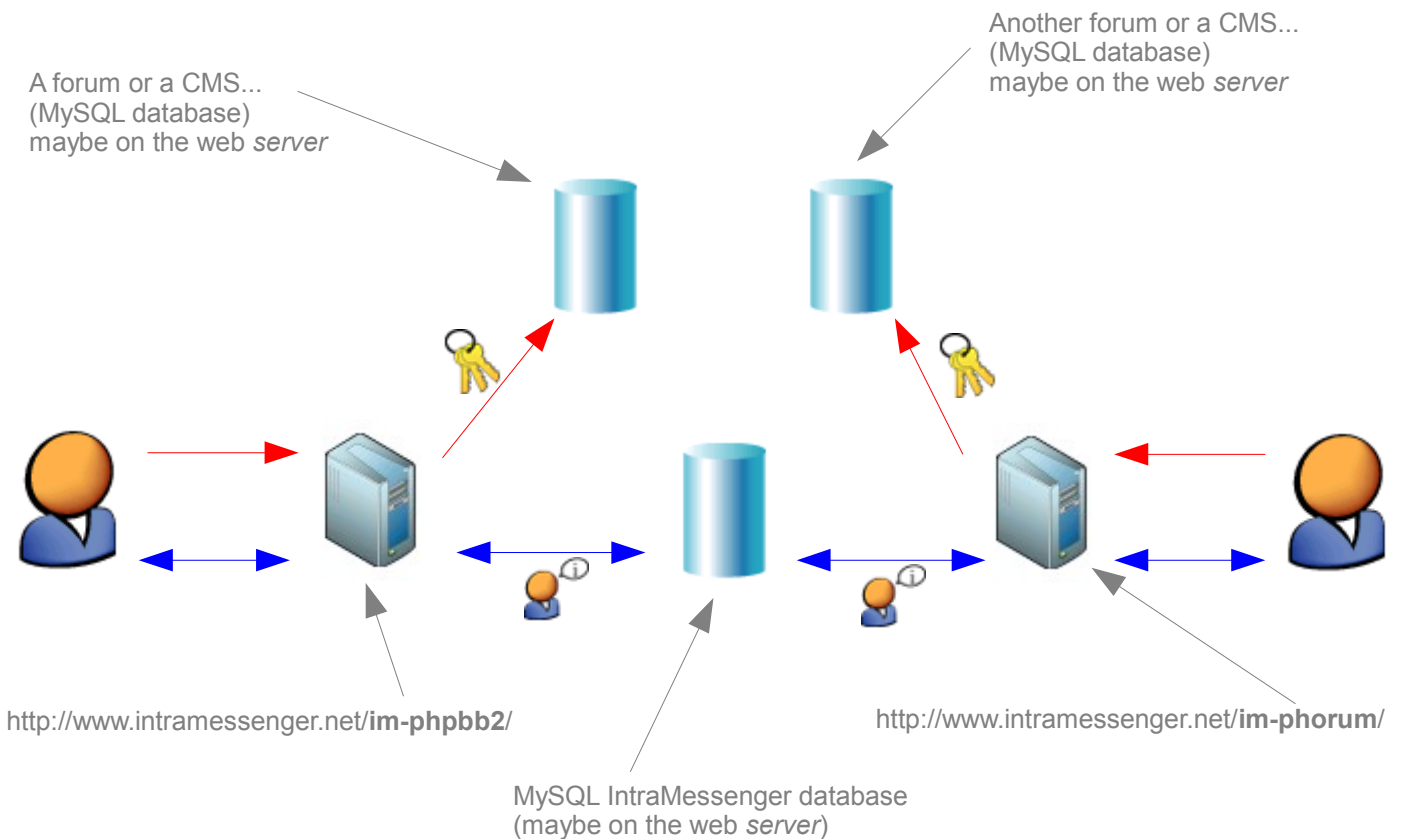

3. Using **IntraMessenger** by two different address (url)
 Just for apply different options to users by address A or B.
 Example : on server A, users can have 3 contacts, and can be only 50 simultaneous,
 on server B, users can have 20 contacts, but can be 200 simultaneous



4. **IntraMessenger** with two extern authentications (example : a forum and a CMS),
